Classroom Music

Classroom Music programmes run over the course of the school year which sees working in schools for a block of 20 weeks or more. We offer a variety of different interactive, educational and fun music programmes that are outlined below. Classroom Music programmes run over the course of the school year from 20+ weeks of tuition. We offer a variety of different classroom music programmes that are outlined below.

These programmes aim to:

- Develop all children into competent musicians.
- Teach children how to read and create music notation
- Develop the technical & musical proficiency of each child and the instrument they're learning
- Increase each child's understanding and knowledge of the world of music



Music in the Classroom

Set on the three core stands of the primary school music curriculum and enjoyed by over 5,000 children across Ireland this interactive, educational and fun music programme gives every child a firm musical foundation. Each class discovers the components that make up music including the conductor and composer; the beat and rhythm; listening and responding to music from around the world; composing music, music notation and song singing. This programme culminates in many classroom performances of the material covered.

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Violin in the Classroom

This classroom-based instrumental course enables schools to offer a weekly violin lesson delivered by a qualified violin teacher. Pupils are immersed into the world of music which radically develops their musical awareness, self-esteem and confidence as musicians and creative thinkers. During classes children learn how to read notation, perform as part of an ensemble and perform different genres of music from all corners of the world.

Mini Musical

Through integrating music with drama and movement our musical theatre programme for primary schools give children a taste of the exciting world of musical theatre. During classes children are taught vocal technique, correct breathing and posture, vocal projection and expressive movement. Each sessions combines these elements as the children learn and perform a section from a well-known musical culminating in the creation of a “Mini Musical”.

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Let's Sing

Our short singing programme for primary schools develops each child's ability to sing in a group setting. Classes explore pitch, vocal tone and make use of the tonic sol-fa. During the duration of the programme students are given regular performance opportunities.
